

Printing your American Heart Association (AHA) certificate of completion

To print your American Heart Association (AHA) certificate of completion, you'll typically download it as a PDF from the AHA eLearning website and then print it from your computer. You can find your certificate under "My Courses" or "Recent Activity" after logging in.

Here's a more detailed breakdown:

1. Log in to the AHA eLearning website: Go to elearning.heart.org and sign in to your account.

2. Navigate to your courses: Locate the "My Courses" section, often found under "Recent Activity" or a similar heading.

3. Select the course: Find the specific course for which you want to download the certificate.

4. Download the certificate: You'll typically find a button or link labeled "Download Certificate" or similar.

5. Save and print: The certificate will likely be downloaded as a PDF file. You can then open the file on your computer and print it.
